Report of the Superintendent:

The DOE announced that school districts will begin receiving allotments under the American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER) Fund this month. These funds may be used to pay for health and safety measures consistent with CDC guidance, address the disruptions to teaching and learning resulting from the pandemic and get students back in the classroom quickly and safely in September 2021.

ESML Analytical, Inc. was called in to remediate environmental damage to ceiling tiles at the Jr/Sr High School outside of Room 109. The area has been temporarily closed. Test results will be provided upon receipt.
