Special Meeting August 28, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Board President Thomas Matarazzo at 6:00 p.m.

Report of the Board President: Dr. Matarazzo welcomed the staff members and wished them well in the new school year.

Report of the Superintendent: Dr. Cirillo explained that a decision must be agreed upon as to how many questions will be on the November election ballot regarding the proposed referendum. The electorate will be presented with one question addressing essential renovations or two questions - one addressing renovations only and the other renovations and expansion.

The question/questions must be submitted to the County Board of Elections by September 6th in order to be included on the November 5th election ballot.

A public forum on the referendum will be held at the Jr/Sr High School on Tuesday, September 10th at 6:00 p.m. At that time all questions concerning the referendum will be addressed.

School begins for faculty and staff on Tuesday, September 3rd and for students on Thursday, September 5th.

Report of the Board Attorney: Mr. Choi is reviewing and addressing all matters that the Board's previous attorney was engaged in. Many of these issues will be discussed with the Board in closed session. The teachers contract and PERC negotiations/mediation is scheduled on Thursday evening, September 26th.

Mr. Choi is assisting Dr. Cirillo in preparation for the September 10th forum and any questions the public may have regarding the proposed referendum.

New Business: Dr. Cirillo recognized Mayor Christopher Chung and thanked him for being present.

Audience Participation:

An audience member questioned the board meeting schedule. The regular board meetings are held on the 3rd Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted. Special or emergency meetings are scheduled as needed.

The football beefsteak fundraiser will be held on Sunday, September 29th at 2:00 p.m. This event will be held at the Elks Club on 10th Street, Palisades Park. Tickets are \$40 and can be purchased at the high school main office.

Rev. Jung questioned the information on the referendum that has been reported in newspaper articles in Korean publications, and whether the information detailed is accurate. Dr. Cirillo said he cannot comment on articles he has not read.

Stephanie Jang translated concerns expressed by Mr. Kwon, NJ Korean/American organization, regarding the referendum. The public is worried about an increase in taxes, and what the actual cost of the renovations/expansion will be.

Mr. Choi, the Board Attorney, suggested that the public attend the September 10th public forum for answers to many of the concerns raised by local citizens.

Nancy Anderegg, secretary at the ECC, thanked the custodial staff for their efforts in getting the schools ready for opening day.

Neris Papoters: Why aren't there enough supplies/activities to keep the children busy during recess?

Maria Pesantes: Stated ongoing concerns regarding the condition of the school buildings, in particular the high school breezeway work that has not been completed.

Jillian Vivanco, ECC principal, inquired why a certain personnel matter was tabled tonight. Ms. Vivanco also remarked that the excess supplies from the 21st C. programs were distributed to each school for use in the appropriate grade levels.

Close Audience Participation:

A motion by Rebekah Lee, second by Stephanie Jang to close audience participation.

Dr. Cirillo thanked Mr. Kwon for his letter and his offer which will be taken under consideration. The September 6th deadline for submission of the November 5th ballot question on the referendum is scheduled by the Board of Elections and not by the Board of Education. It cannot be changed. The district website will offer more information on the referendum schedule. Mayor Chung also announced that the Borough will address the referendum on their website.

Board member Jason Kim announced that the Board and Dr. Cirillo will communicate more frequently with the Korean media in order to keep them updated on any issues pertaining to the referendum.

Dr. Cirillo said the high school breezeway floor tile project is nearing completion. It will be open to the students and the public shortly.

Mr. Ben Choi replied to the issue regarding the personnel matter that was tabled. The Board Secretary will send a Rice notice to the individual in question at least 48 hours prior to the next board meeting. That individual has the choice to have the matter discussed in public or private session.
